

Cabin Fever

Cutting and assembly diagrams

Cutting instructions for both of the blocks in *Design Studio: Cabin Fever* along with assembly diagrams are provided here. Note that the cutting is for one block. Read more about piecing designs into Log Cabin blocks in *Design Studio: Cabin Fever* in *QUILTMAKER* Nov/Dec '09 (No. 130). If you cannot find this issue at your local quilt shop, order back issues at quiltmaker.com/shop.

There are no fabric colors listed in the cutting charts. Refer to the photographed blocks and assembly diagrams for color selection.

The triangle shapes in the logs are all made from N's using the stitch and flip technique. The tree branches are also sewn using this technique. Place a patch in the corner of another patch, right sides together. Mark a diagonal line and sew on the line. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4", flip the patch open and press gently.

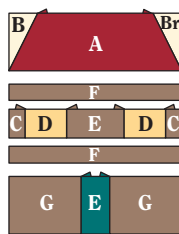
- 1 each templates A, B and Br
- 2 rectangles (C) 1" x 1 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (D) 1 1/2" x 2"
- 2 rectangles (E) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (F) 1" x 6 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (G) 2 1/2" x 3"

for light logs:

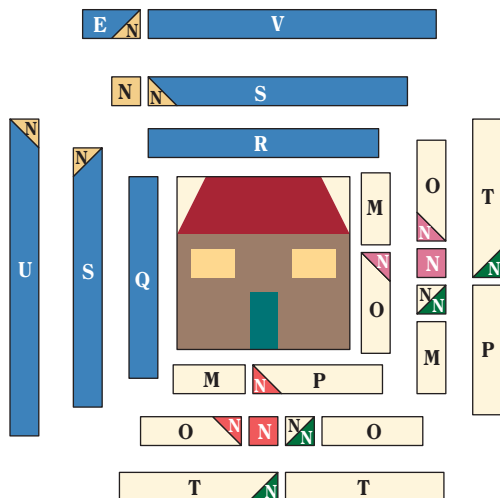
- 3 rectangles (M) 1 1/2" x 3"
- 12 squares (N) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 4 rectangles (O) 1 1/2" x 4"
- 2 rectangles (P) 1 1/2" x 5"
- 3 rectangles (T) 1 1/2" x 6"

for dark logs:

- 1 rectangle (E) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 5 squares (N) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (Q) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (R) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (S) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (U) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (V) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"

for tree:

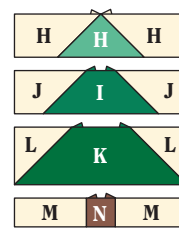
- 3 rectangles (H) 2" x 3 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (I) 2" x 4 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (J) 2" x 3"
- 1 rectangle (K) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"
- 2 squares (L) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (M) 1 1/2" x 3"
- 1 square (N) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

for light logs:

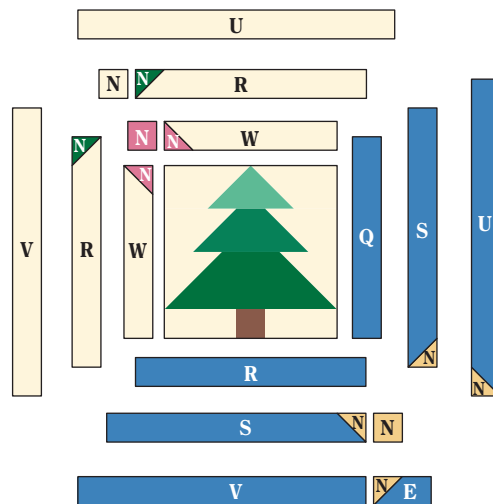
- 6 squares (N) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (R) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (U) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (V) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (W) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"

for dark logs:

- 1 rectangle (E) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 5 squares (N) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (Q) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (R) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- 2 rectangles (S) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (U) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2"
- 1 rectangle (V) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"

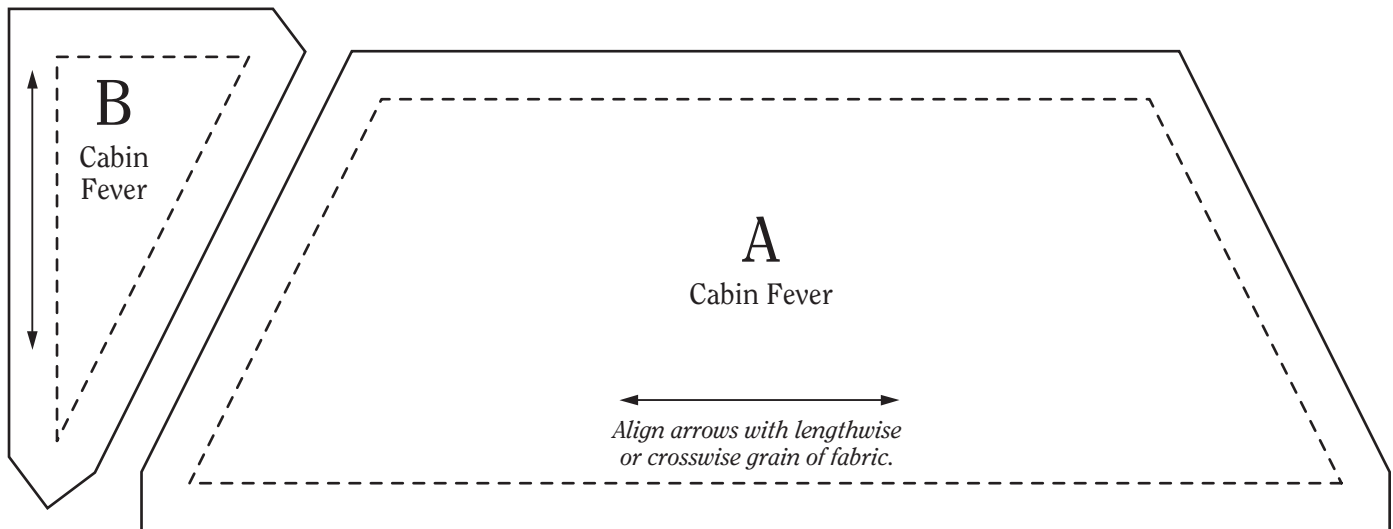


Tree
