

Here's how you make *Bitty Love*.



## Cutting

Heart fabric

2 rectangles 2" x 3.5" (can be the same fabric or two different fabrics)

Background fabric

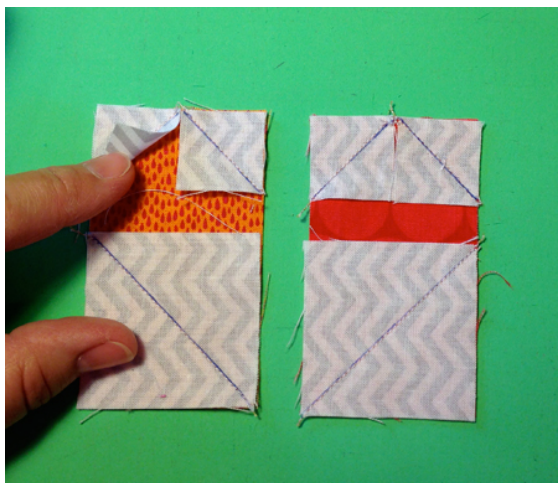
4 squares 1" x 1"

2 squares 2" x 2"

## Sewing

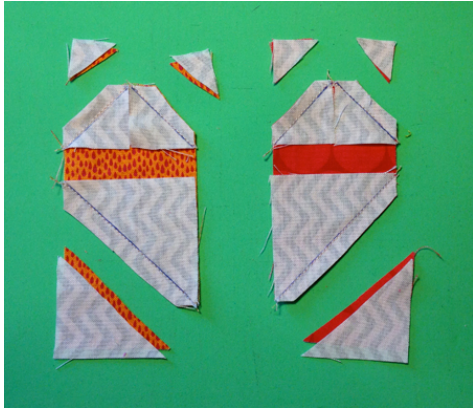
This block uses "Stitch and Flip" to attach the background patches to the heart patches.

Place two small background squares at one end of each heart rectangle, right sides together. Sew from corner to corner on each square as shown. Be sure to sew them as shown so they form a little peak in the middle.



Place a 2" background square at the other end of each rectangle. On the wrong side of the 2" square, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown. Sew on the marked line. Be sure to sew them in opposite

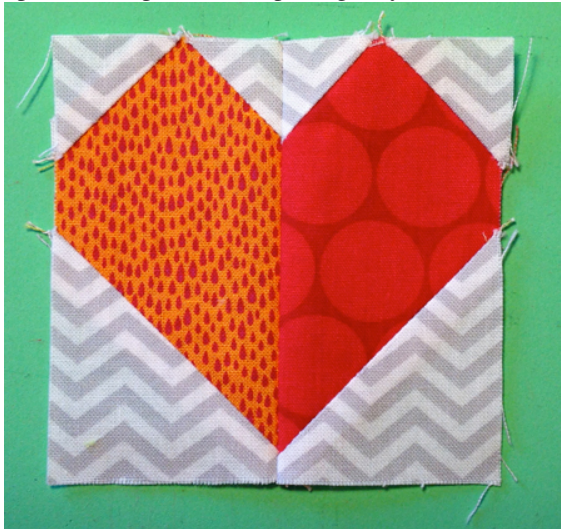
directions as shown on the patches above.



Trim the seam allowances to 1/4" and discard the trimmings.



Open out the patches and press gently.



Sew the heart halves together to complete the block.
