Corrections

The cutting dimensions for border #1 and border #3 in Starstruck on page 39 in the July/August '10 issue (No. 134) are incorrect. The cutting dimensions for the border #1 strips should be 3" x 40" and the border #3 strips should be 3½" x 40".

If the fabric has already been cut for borders #1 and #3, adjust the corner units to fit the borders as follows:

From the remaining fabric, cut new patches for F–J:

Dark Blue Batik

1 square (F) 3½" x 3½"

Medium Blue Batik #1

2 rectangles (G) 1" x 3½"

2 rectangles (H) 1" x 4"

Red Batik

1 square (F) 3½" x 3½"

Medium Blue Batik

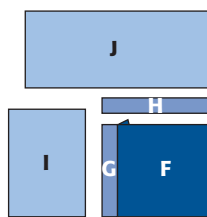
2 rectangles (I) 3" x 4"

2 rectangles (J) 3" x 6½"

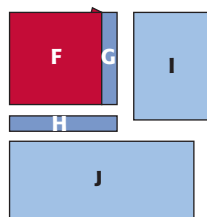
Sew the patches together as shown to make border corner units 1 and 2.

Follow the original pattern to assemble the borders and finish the quilt.
